## SPAY-NEUTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INFORMATION



**S**TOP the Overpopulation of Pets, Inc. is a nonprofit organization dedicated to saving lives by preventing births of unwanted dogs and cats in Alaska. We pay \$20-\$40 (depending on gender and species of pet) toward spay/neuter costs for needy pet owners. There is also no limit on the number of spay/neuter vouchers you can send to STOP, as long as you are an individual and the pets are yours. After receiving your voucher, you will make your own appointment at the participating veterinarian.

You will need to bring your voucher with you to the participating veterinarian. I Thank you, and congratulations for making the right choice in getting your pets spayed and neutered.

### OUR MISSION

STOP the Overpopulation of Pets is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation dedicated to paying for spaying and neutering dogs and cats in order to eliminate the killing of excess animals in Alaska's animal control shelters. Our secondary mission is to educate pet owners and potential pet owners about pet care, pet-related issues, training, and concerns in order to better the lives of pet owners, pets, and the community.

### OUR GOAL

STOP the Overpopulation of Pets is dedicated to saving lives by preventing births. Therefore, we pay a portion of spay/neuter charges (currently [June 2005] \$20-\$40 depending on the gender and species of the pet) to participating veterinarians. The veterinarians must bill STOP directly for the amount on the voucher. Prices at veterinary clinics vary.

### OUR SUCCESS

Between October 2002 and May 2005, STOP sent out over 2,200 vouchers to pay a portion of spaying and neutering costs for Alaska's pets. Our goal is to sharply reduce the number of pets killed at Alaska's animal control centers.
